12 teams selected and seeded by the College Football Playoff committee following conference championship weekend.



SEED RANKING

Four highest-ranked teams receive a first-round bye into the quarterfinals. The eight remaining teams play based on seeding with the higher ranked team playing on its campus or at a location of its choice.



Teams seeded No.5 to 12 will play at the campus of the higher seed or a location of their choice.

The top four teams will receive a first-round bye.









The semifinals take place at the Orange and Cotton Bowl. The No.1 seed will receive preferential placement.
