## **SEED RANKING**

Four highest-ranked conference champions receive a first-round bye into the quarterfinals. The eight remaining teams play based on seeding with the higher ranked team playing on its campus or at a location of its choice.



Teams seeded No.5 to 12 will play at the campus of the higher seed or a location of their choice.


The top four conference champions will receive a first-round bye.
