12 teams selected and seeded by the College Football Playoff committee following conference championship weekend on Sunday, Dec. 8.

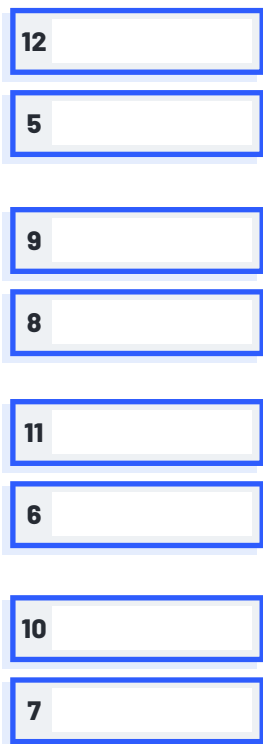


SEED RANKING

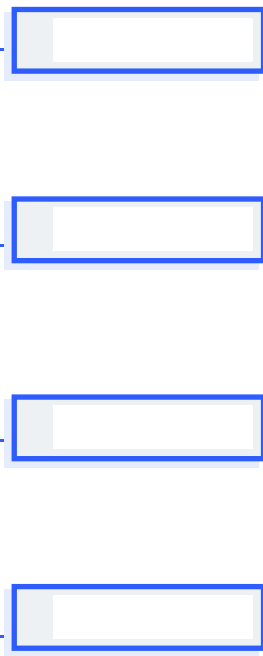
QUARTERFINALS PLAYOFF

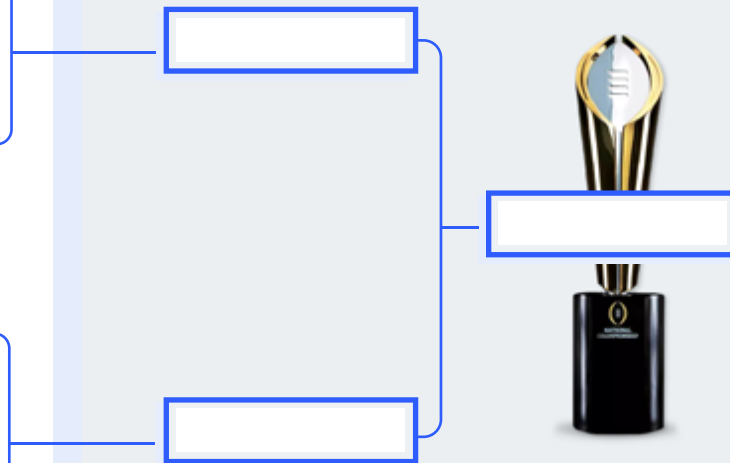
SEMIFINALS PLAYOFF
